**PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**

- Open *only* to UJA-Federation Network Summer Camps and JCCs
- Offers \$15,000 – \$20,000 over the course of 18 months in staff salary support and greening grants to each participating agency
- Creates a cohort of agency staff throughout the Network dedicated to greening
- Provides extensive training and consulting support to Fellows and other agency staff on fundamentals of Jewish environmental education including how to green your agency
- Facilitates an energy audit to identify low cost measures to reduce energy consumption and save money
- Helps build community and integrate environmental education into agency programming

**AGENCIES WILL RECEIVE**

- The opportunity to send a staff Fellow to a series of inspiring and informational day-long Greening Workshops at UJA-Federation over the course of 18 months
- The opportunity for other agency staff and lay leaders to attend individual Greening Workshops relevant to their roles and interests
- \$6,000 per year (over the course of 2 years) to supplement the salary of the staff Fellow
- The opportunity to apply for supporting grants for environmental audits, environmental improvement projects and environmental education programs
- Environmental Leadership training retreats for Fellows at the Isabella Freedman Jewish Retreat Center and the Teva Learning Center
- The ability to galvanize the interests of young lay leaders who are passionate about this important issue

**AGENCIES WILL NEED TO**

- Designate an interested, motivated and appropriate staff member\* to apply for the Fellowship
- Commit to fully participate in the program and support the work of your Fellow

*\*Fellows should be educators and/or other program staff with the capacity to leverage change at your agency. Other staff, including those in operations, purchasing, etc., will be invited to those workshops in the series that are relevant to their work as “Greening Partners.”*
