Job Description

The Sous Chef works under the supervision of the Executive Chef to prepare meals in an efficient and cost effective manner, creating delicious, nutritious and well presented meals within budgetary and dietary constraints. Individual should have experience with whole foods cooking and a strong desire to prepare food that is healthy, visually appealing and seasonal. Vegetarian and/or baking experience a huge plus. Sous Chef must be committed to upholding the kosher standards of the Isabella Freedman Kitchen.

Our Food

We strive to serve food that is locally sourced, minimally processed, and sustainably grown. The type of food we serve reflects the desires of our diverse clientele – (e.g. kid friendly food for our kid's programs, senior friendly for our senior campers, high-end gourmet food for our wedding clients). We provide high quality vegetarian food at all meals. Our four-acre organic farm provides much of the kitchen's produce during the summer and fall seasons.

Our Community

The community at Isabella Freedman includes a half dozen year round permanent staff and as many as 40 short-term staff throughout the year. Residents include our team of environmental educators, ADAMAH Fellows and faculty, Elat Chayyim staff and interns, and Summer Camp staff. Together we create a community committed to environmental sustainability, social justice and vibrant Jewish spiritual life.
